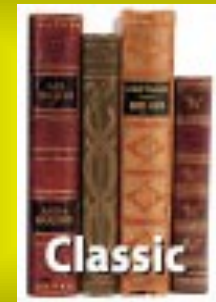

Chronicles the joys and sorrows of the four March sisters as they grow into young ladies in nineteenth-century New England. Grades 4-7

The Indian in the Cupboard* JF Banks, Lynne Reid
A nine-year-old boy receives a plastic Indian, a cupboard, and a little key for his birthday and finds himself involved in adventure when the Indian comes to life in the cupboard and befriends him. Grades 4-6
