# ***Pysanky : Ukrainian Egg Decorating***

**A pysanka is a Ukrainian Easter egg decorated with traditional Ukrainian folk designs using a wax-resist method. The word pysanka comes from the Ukrainian verb “pysaty” which means *to write*. The designs are not painted on, but *written* in beeswax. Olga Kobryn will talk about this ancient art of egg decorating and will explain the methods the symbols used and the colors applied. A short film by Slavko Novitsky will also be shown.**
