

# Download Library eBooks to Your Kindle or Kindle App

## You will need:

- A valid Old Bridge Library card
- Access to the internet
- Amazon account information pertaining to your registered Kindle device or Kindle app

## Sign in to [elibrarynj.com](http://elibrarynj.com)

- Click the 'Sign In' link in the top right corner of the website.
- Choose Libraries of Middlesex Automation Consortium
- Enter your library card number when prompted.
- Optionally, select 'Remember me on this device' to store your library card number when on a personal machine (you will still need to manually sign in).

## Find and borrow ebooks

- Browse by category, view covers of new and recently returned books, and search for specific authors and titles.
- Move the mouse over each cover for a 'Borrow' or 'Place a Hold' button. Click on the title for more information about the book.

## Download to Kindle / sync via Amazon.com

- Click the download button, select Kindle, and confirm.  
(If a Kindle version is not available, return the book and choose another.)
- Sign in to your Amazon account.
- Select the device to which you will sync your book, click 'Continue'.
- The book will be downloaded to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app the next time it syncs with Amazon.
- If required, download the book to your computer and transfer via USB cable.

## Return ebooks early (optional)

- To return an ebook before its due date, sign into your Amazon account and go to 'Manage Your Content and Devices'.
- Find the item you wish to return, click on the Actions button, and select 'Return this book'.
