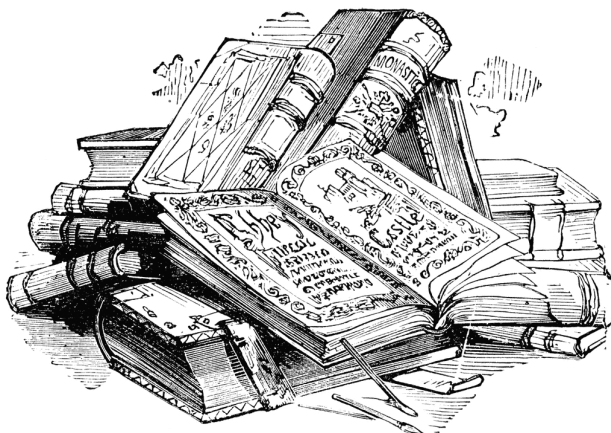
Cinderella is Dead
